#### What does the leadership look like?

The leadership of Turin C.O.G.I.C. is pastor-led, elder-supported, and deacon-served. Together, along with the church mother and missionaries, they shepherd, govern, teach, and counsel the people of Turin C.O.G.I.C. in accordance to God's Word, our Statement of Faith, and the church Doctrine. Pastor Charlie J. Barkley is the Senior Pastor who has general oversight of the church. He provides leadership in the areas of: Worship, Preaching, Vision-Casting, Administration, and Counseling. Elder Jonathan Cooper is the Assistant Pastor, and he assists Elder Barkley in the areas of preaching, teaching, and leadership training. Elder Eddie Jones, Sr. is an associate pastor who also preaches and teaches.

#### What are elders?

"Elders lead the church [1 Tim 5:17; Titus 1:7; 1 Peter 5:1-2], teach and preach the Word [1 Timothy 3:2; 2 Timothy 4:2; Titus 1:9], protect the church from false teachers [Acts 20:17, 28-31], exhort and admonish the saints in sound doctrine [1 Timothy 4:13; 2 Timothy 3:13-17; Titus 1:9], visit the sick and pray [James 5:14; Acts 20:35], and judge doctrinal issues [Acts 15:16]. In biblical terminology, elders **shepherd**, **oversee**, **lead**, and **care** for the local church" First, in Acts 20:28, elders are encouraged in the "pastoral" duties of overseeing and shepherding. Second, in 1 Peter 5:1-2, elders are exhorted to "shepherd" the flock of God that is in their charge, which is the role of a pastor. Third, in Ephesians 4:11, pastors are treated as teachers. Their responsibilities and qualifications are very similar to those of a servant/deacon with the added duties of teaching. The elders of Turin serve alongside the Senior

> Pastor in providing leadership and accountability to each other and to the body.
